How much is a Child's Life Worth?



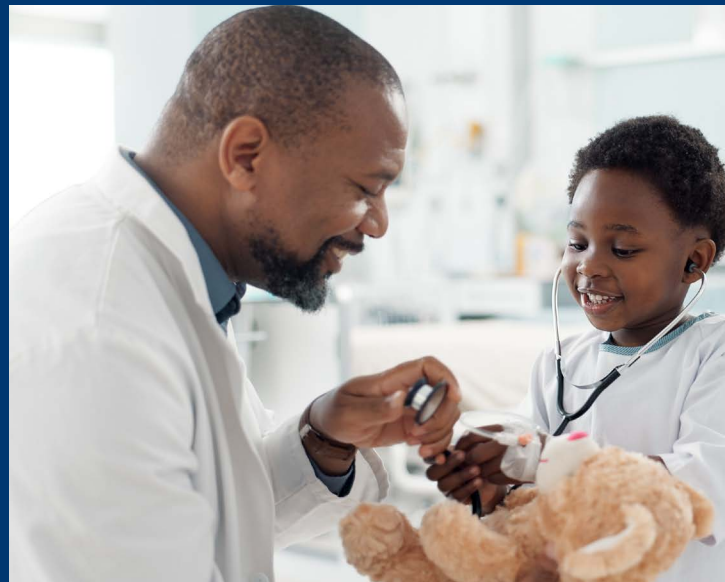
In 2022, 4.9 million children worldwide died before reaching 5 years of age: 13,400 children every day.



Many of these children would be alive if they were born in a country, able to provide the medical care they needed.



We believe there should be no boundaries for children in need of medical care.





The Pope's Global Alliance for the Health of Children

On May 11th, the second meeting of Brotherhood organized by Cardinal Mauro Gambetti took place in the Vatican, the so-called BE HUMAN event.

In this context, the project of creating a Centre for Humanitarian Care was presented to the Holy Father.

"[...] We want to create a Centre that helps children get the medical treatment they need and helps doctors and nurses receive specialized consultations and training. We want to build a large community for children around the world."

The Holy Father welcomed the project and encouraged its implementation.

The Pope entrusted the **Patrons of the World's Children's Hospitals** to implement the Pope's Global Alliance for the Health and Humanitarian Care of Children.

The project has two main objectives:

Create a global network for Children



2

Provide Humanitarian care for children from all over the world







The Global Network of Childhood

On May 11, 2024, during the BE HUMAN event, at a technical table dedicated to Children, a collaboration was launched with the Organizing Committee of the World Children's Day.

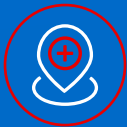
The Committee will be responsible for establishing a global network for children through initiatives and events worldwide, with the participation of prominent public figures.





The Worldwide Network of the Pope's Global Alliance

This project utilizes a Hub and Spoke model: a core group of Hubs will train medical professionals and treat children proposed by a global network of Spokes.



HUBS

Hospitals around the world that will:

- Evaluate clinical cases and provide the necessary treatments to the selected patients
- Conduct on-site and online training
- Administer telemedicine and teleconsultation services
- Provide on-site care when needed



SPOKES

On the frontlines in countries around the world, Christian missions, Catholic health centres, other hospitals, NGOs will:

- Identify the children in need of urgent care
- Submit the requests for help and support
- Present all documentations on the clinical cases
- Submit requests for medical training



The Network of Hubs and Spokes

The goal is to start with **3-5 Hubs¹** and several **Spokes** belonging to the network of **CUAMM²** and **PIME³**

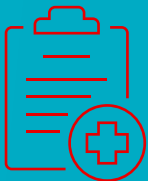
The Platform

The meeting point between HUBs and SPOKES will be a multilingual digital platform created by **Almaviva** and **Salesforce**.

The PLATFORM will be used:



As a sort of *marketplace* where accredited SPOKES can submit a case, request training and telemedicine, or the intervention of medical teams in case of emergencies.



To manage administrative tasks, such as uploading all documentation related to a clinical case and guaranteeing that the case needs *pro bono* humanitarian aid.

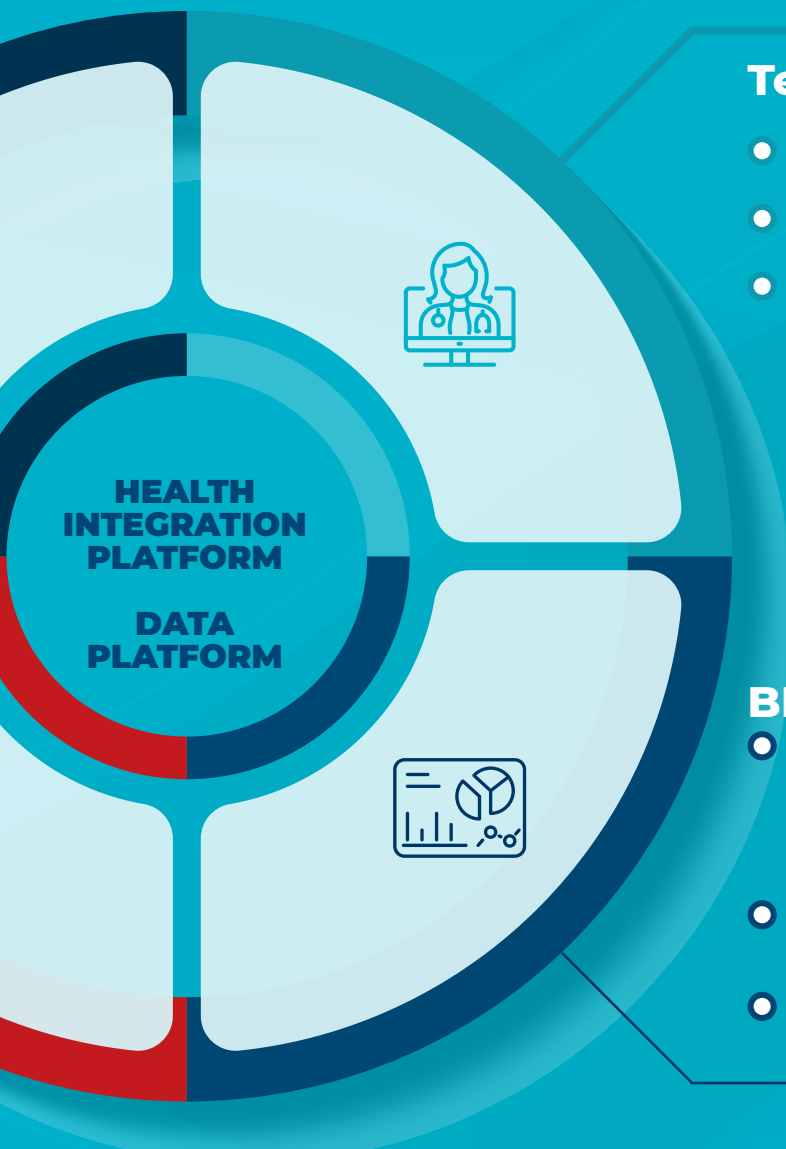
Submission and Evaluation of clinical cases

- Clinical specialties (oncology, cardiology etc.) and specific Treatments.
- Upload of all documentation on clinical cases in compliance with privacy.

Customer Relations Management

- Selection of the HUB based on clinical cases, preferences and timelines.
- Logistic support and documentation for transfer.





Telemedicine services

- Teleconsultation
- Televisit
- Telemonitoring

BI & Analytics - AI - NLP

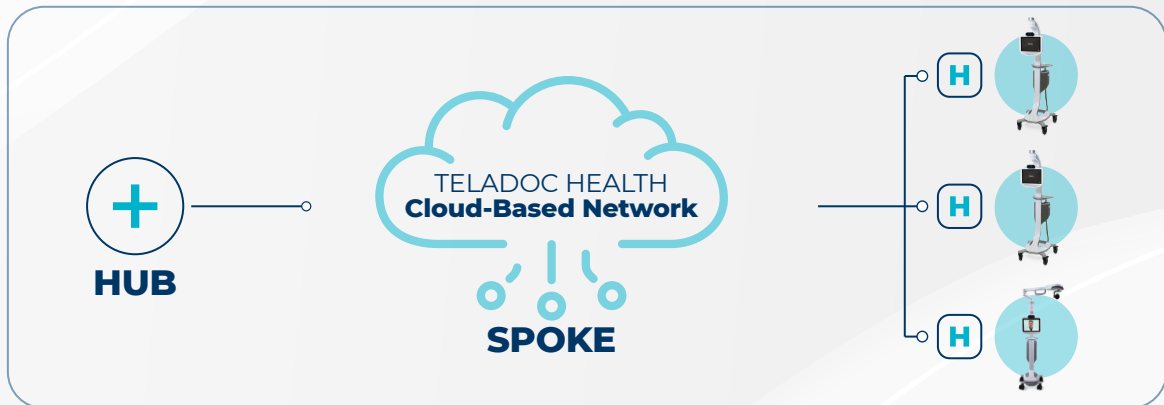
- AI support for the analysis of clinical cases and related documentation.

The platform is designed to interface with **Teladoc Health** telemedicine device system to ensure that healthcare providers do not have to worry about connectivity.

Storage compartment for secure peripheral storage

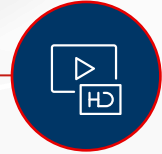


Enhanced peripheral integration for real-time streaming of valuable medical data from live auscultation and HD medical imaging equipment





High-definition (HD) cameras for clearer situational awareness and detailed examination



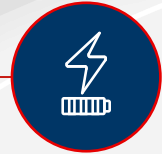
Intuitive touch screen interface provides a best-in-class user experience




Compact, maneuverable design, fits below a hospital bed
